### **Important Instructions:**

- Parents must be seated in the auditorium 10 minutes prior to the show.
- The Annual Social Programme will begin promptly at the specified time hence; parents are requested to be seated in the given timing. This will help to conclude the programme around the scheduled time.
- Late arrivals will not be accommodated and no requests or arguments regarding participation will be entertained.
- It must be noted that entry without an invitation card will strictly not be allowed. The school will not be able to allow more than 2 adults. We would like to bring to the notice of the parents that the seating capacity of 'Annabhau Sathe Sanskrutik Sabhagruha' is 850 and the number of students performing for each section is around 350 to 400.
- Patience and co-operation on the part of the parents will be appreciated while the invitation passes are being collected by the teachers. Invitation Cards will be sent online through WhatsApp & e-mail.

- The students will be given 2 entry passes (hard copy) which parents need to carry along with them (1 pass per adult).
- Non-participants of Std. 10 can come to watch the performance. They need to wear regular school uniform, socks and shoes and I- Card. One of the parents can accompany the student.
- The students who have appeared for Std. 10 exam can come to see the programmes on 28<sup>th</sup>, Tuesday during the time slot 5:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. They need to wear regular school uniform, socks and shoes and I- Card. If any parent wishes to come for the programme they need to collect the invitation pass from the school office **on Thursday, 23<sup>rd</sup> April 2026.** .
- Please note that sibling, friend or ex- student will not be allowed.

- Please follow the timings given to drop your ward at **‘Annabhau Sathe Sanskrutik Sabhagruha’**. If you are early or late by 15 minutes or more, it will create traffic jam for which school authorities cannot be held responsible.

### **Parking**

- 2 and 4-wheeler parking is available at the auditorium but it would be preferable if parents commute by 2 wheelers to avoid rush in the parking area.

### **Seating Arrangement**

- Rows A and B are reserved for the guests, dignitaries and the staff of the school.
- Parents can occupy places from ‘C’ row onwards on first come first serve basis. Most of the parents can be accommodated on the ground floor of the auditorium. In case it is crowded downstairs, you are requested to occupy seats in the balcony.
- Parents are requested to co-operate with the volunteers and teachers at the main gate and come in a queue to avoid chaos and arguments.
- At times the parents with babies in the arms, occupy the first row which disturbs the guests and the performers. We are sure you will take a note of this and take appropriate action if you observe so.
- We hope you will observe these rules strictly.

### **Make Up and Costumes**

- Please wash your child’s hair on this day so it is not sticky and oily. Girls should not wear bangles, gajaras, anklets or any other ornaments unless the teachers have given specific instructions. They **MUST NOT** wear any gold or silver jewellery on the Annual Social Day. Wearing Tattoos, Nail paints, Mehendi, Bindis and heavy make-up should be avoided strictly. School will not be responsible for the lost property.
- Please see that your child is decently dressed on this day. Taxing of jewellery and make up creates hindrance in actual performance.
- If the child is going to wear a rental dress, parents must send one extra dress in a labelled bag.
- If the child is wearing own dress it needs to be decent. Spaghettis and backless tops are prohibited. Ghagra or Saree should not be tied below the navel.
- Sleeveless dresses will not be allowed.
- Wearing a slip and cycling short beneath the frock/dress is compulsory.

### **Photographs**

- Video / Still cameras are **NOT** allowed inside the auditorium.
- Please note that individual photographs will not be and should not be clicked.
- The video links will be shared with the parents by the school.

### **We have few requests to make**

- Children must be well fed before coming for the programme. They can carry a small bag with a labelled water bottle, napkin, carry bag to keep their footwear. Light snacks will be provided by the school.
- Students of Pre-Primary section should carry their regular basket with a labelled water bottle and a napkin.
- Do not litter the auditorium with plastic bags, paper napkins and containers of eatables etc.
- Switch off your mobiles during the programme.
- Do not request us to allow the siblings inside the auditorium. Please make arrangements for the same, as we have very limited sitting capacity.

### **General Rules and Regulations**

- It is our sincere request to the parents that they should not disturb the teachers by entering through the side doors in the auditorium. It is not possible for the teachers to hand over any child between the programmes as it disturbs the teachers and the children.
- All the children will be handed over to the parents after the complete programme of that section gets over. Parents should strictly follow the announcements made by the teacher after the complete programme gets over. Parents should come in a queue to pick up their children to avoid further chaos and co-operate with the volunteers.
- All the children and staff have worked hard for the programme. Hence, we request all the parents to watch the programme till the end and cheer our little ones.

### **Special Note for Std. 8 & 9 Students**

- Parents need to pick and drop, even the students of Std. 8 and 9. They will not be let alone by the teachers, neither they should carry their mobiles or come on two wheelers.

A sincere and earnest request to co-operate with teachers and volunteers while picking / dropping children at the auditorium and parking.

Be a conscious parent and have trust in teachers and faith in volunteers who would be taking care of your children. Let us all learn to respect each other and have continuous support and guidance. It is always better to be together and together we can achieve success.
